REVISION OF WAREHOUSE CHARGES AS PER SCHEDULE II – APPENDIX ‘C’ OF THE S.T.A.C. RULES

Dear Sirs,

In the Warehousing Advisory Body meeting held on 11th September, 2018 an agreement was reached between the members of Warehousing Advisory Body of the Committee and representatives of Siliguri Tea Warehousing Association to revise the Warehouse Charges under Schedule II – Appendix ‘C’ (Rates on Sellers and Buyers Account) of the Siliguri Tea Auction Committee Rules. **The revision of warehouse charges as follows will be effective from Sale 14, Apr.2018 on Sellers account and from 01/10/2018 on Buyers account of post sale teas lying in the Warehouses.**

A	Receiving into warehouse, repairing major and minor and minor damages caused in transit gross weighment, stacking at location, for category inspection by Brokers, boring, bunging, re-weighment of sample chests, with free rent up to 30 days on Sellers’ account only, except in the case of private forward contracts when it will be transferable to the Buyer’s account as from the prompt date. This charge will in no circumstances be refunded.	Rs.21.50
B	Un loading from lorries, weighing chests, stacking, boring, bunging on Sellers account.	Rs.4.00
C	Rent after 30 days up to and including prompt date per week or part of a week, payable by Seller.	Rs.6.00
